Situated in the heart of Adare Village, Adare Manor is one of Ireland's most evocative and spellbinding hotels. The estate is home to a championship golf course designed by Robert Trent Jones Senior and offers superb trout fishing on the River Maigue. Guests can stroll through the stonewalled gardens and winding woodland paths, discover the colourful history of Adare Manor and its story-filled walls.

From golf competitions on the award-winning Robert Trent Jones, Sr. designed golf course to team building activities including fly fishing, archery, and more, or candlelit dinners in the exquisite ballroom, Adare Manor has the lot.





5* DROMOLAND CASTLE

Dromoland Castle is Ireland's award-winning premier luxury resort. DAY 1 - ARRIVALS, OPTIONAL ACTIVITIES AT YOUR HOTEL

Arriving in Shannon Airport, you will be greeted and transferred to your luxury 5 star hotel. Upon arrival at your hotel, you will be greeted at the main gate by **a horse and hound welcome** which will escort you through the grounds to the hotel. Enjoy a welcome lunch before choosing from a range of optional activities such as:

Adare Manor: In **Adare Village** the streets are lined with rows of thatched roofed cottages and floral displays are blooming everywhere. There are award winning restaurants and pubs with Irish music in the village, full of characters and craic, you can stroll to the village from Adare Manor in 5 minutes, a beautiful walk indeed.

Dromoland Castle: Visit **Ennis**. This historical town is certainly one of Clare's most characterful and picturesque centres – with its narrow, winding streets, historical buildings and busy market town atmosphere. At the same time, the town has many modern influences – making Ennis a town that is very much about 'then and now'.

This evening enjoy a dinner in your hotel. During the drinks reception choose a gift at your special pop up Aran Sweater store. Afterwards enjoy a casual buffet dinner.



DAY 2 - CLIFFS OF MOHER AND BUNRATTY CASTLE AND FOLK PARK

Enjoy breakfast in the hotel. Today we will take on a tour of Ireland's Wild Atlantic Way. We will take a stop to visit the spectacular **Cliffs of Moher**. The Cliffs of Moher are some of Europe's highest sea cliffs and amongst the most impressive coastlines in the world. The crowning glory of the Clare coastline, like a viewing platform for prehistoric giants who wish to peer over the edge of Europe, the cliffs provide an unrivalled view across the vast boiling wildness of the Atlantic Ocean, a world unchanged since the pre-Celtic masters of magic, the Tuatha Dé Danann ruled Ireland

Continuing on to Bunratty. Lunch at the original **Durty Nellys Pub** before a visit to **Bunratty castle and Folk Park**. Experience a window on Ireland's past and explore the acclaimed 15th century Bunratty Castle and the 19th century Bunratty Folk Park. The centre attraction of Bunratty is Bunratty Castle, a castle mostly decorated with 15th and 16th century furnishings. Bunratty Folk Park recreates rural and urban life of 19th century Ireland where visitors can view farmhouses of various economic backgrounds, village-street and church, and the recently renovated walled vernacular gardens. The most complete and authentic medieval fortress in Ireland. Built in 1425 it was restored in 1954 to its former medieval splendour and now contains mainly 15th and 16th century furnishings, tapestries, and works of art which capture the mood of those times.

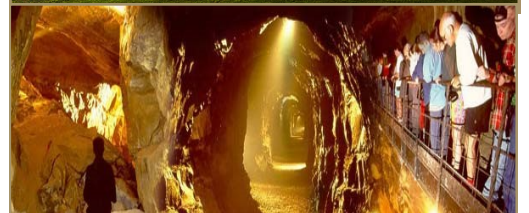
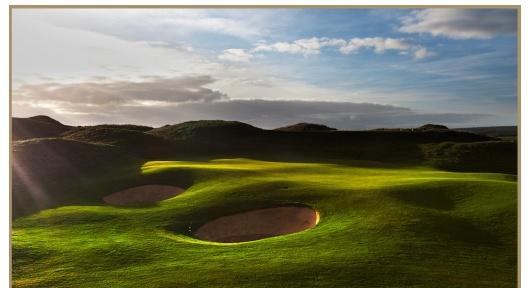
Tonight enjoy a casual pub night in Adare Village complete with entertainment



DAY 3 - OPTIONAL ACTIVITIES

Today you can choose from the following optional activities;

- **Golfing at Lahinch** - Founded in 1927, Lahinch Golf Club stands as one of the oldest golf clubs in Ireland. The towering sand dunes that cover the landscape are incorporated seamlessly with the rolling greens and undulating fairways. Like any classic links course, there are a number of blind shots to challenge golfers.
- **The Burren and Ailwee Caves tour** - Transfer into the heart of the Burren in County Clare, visit Ailwee Caves. Expert guides will accompany you on a 30 minute stroll through the beautiful caverns, over bridged chasms, under weird formations and alongside the thunderous waterfall. Marvel at the frozen waterfall and explore the hibernation chambers of long-extinct brown bears. Enjoy Lunch before exploring more of the burren including a short hike to view the Poul nabrone Dolmen, a megalithic tomb that dates from about 3500 BC, is the most outstanding of Ireland's many dolmens. It's a remarkable structure, and a place that seems to really leave a lasting impression.
- **Cooking class and Limerick city tour** - Transfer to Limerick City for a cooking class followed by a tour of the city. Our team of enthusiastic and friendly



Chefs will ensure you gain the confidence, knowledge and techniques needed to improve your culinary skills, all within a warm and fun filled environment. After lunch we will take a tour of Limerick City. Highlights along the route include St. Mary's Cathedral and King John's Castle. The castle was built in 1200, but the island it stands on was first occupied by the Vikings in 922. You'll also see the Treaty Stone, erected to mark the end of the Williamite War in 1691 after the city was besieged for two years. The tour is a great way to familiarise yourself with the city and discover Limerick's fascinating history.



Tonight transfer to Limerick City for dinner at Hamptons Restaurant.

DAY 4 - BOAT TOUR OF KILLALOE LAKE WITH PRIVATE HOME VISITS

Get to see the parts of Ireland many rarely do as we gain exclusive access to a range of extraordinary private properties, while meeting many charismatic characters in their very own homes. Travel by passenger boat as we gain a unique insight to Ireland's Lakelands from a whole new vantage point

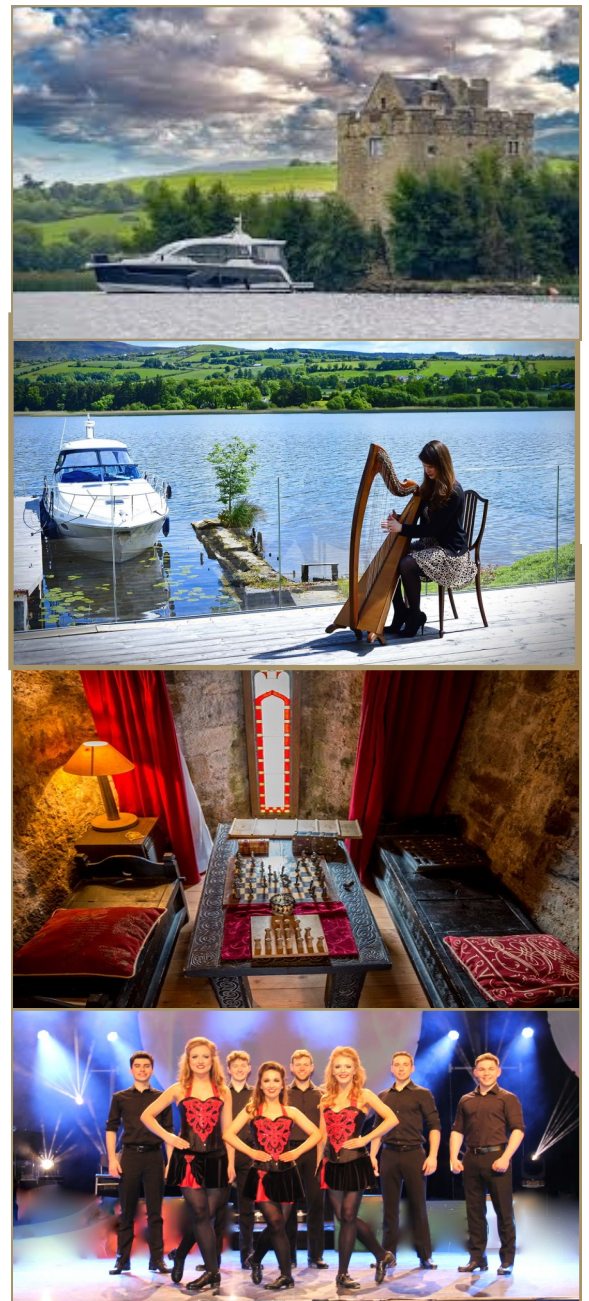

After lunch experience 'new' Ireland as we arrive to the private deck of a modern **Villa**, designed by world renowned Irish architect. Here we meet the owners and view their private collection of contemporary Irish art & sculpture. Enjoy a watercolours art class from the deck of the landscape opposite by our arts facilitator followed by a seafood platter meal in a dining room with 300 degree views, with an abundance of genuine Irish hospitality
